INGREDIENTS

1-cup of Sameid (semolina)

1 egg

1 cup sugar

½ tsp vanilla

3 cups 2% milk

1 cup pistachios (chopped really fine)

½ cup coconut (dried)

1 can of Nestle table cream (7.6 oz)

COOKING INSTRUCTIONS

- Mix eggs and sugar in a cooking pan until fluffy (using mixer or by hand).
- Add milk and Sameid and heat on medium heat until boiling. Must stir constantly to prevent it from sticking to the bottom of the pan.
- Once it has reached boiling point, add vanilla and place on 9 x 4 flat pan (with an edge). Let it set for at least 15 minutes.
- Spread the Nestle cream evenly on top and set in the fridge for at least 1/2 hour or until serving.
- Before serving, decorate with coconut and pistachios (to taste). Serve with maple syrup. Enjoy!
